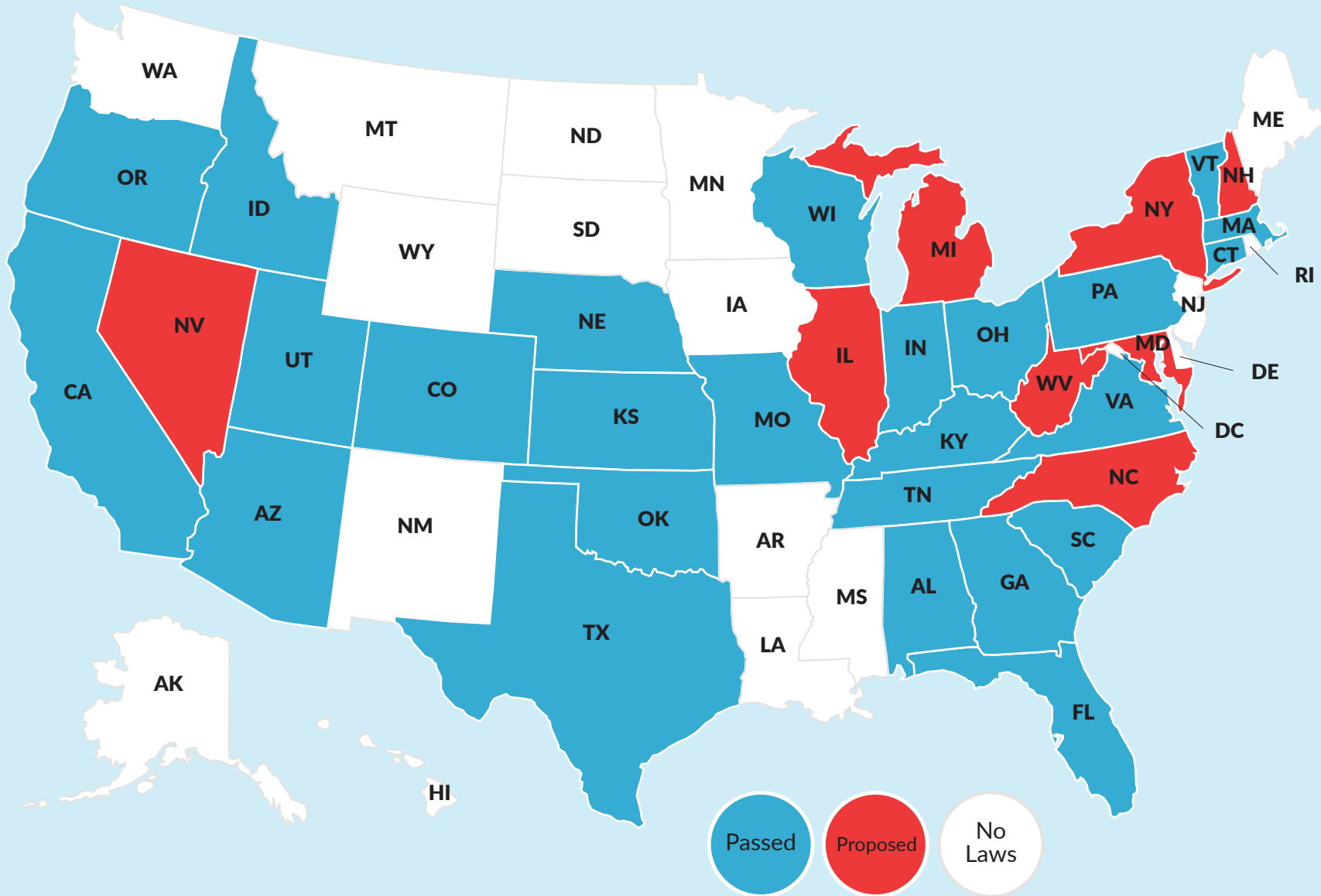


Good Samaritan State Laws
