It's the saddest story of the summer. Each year dozens of American children die in cars in the heat. Some of these cases occur when a parent forgets there's a kid in the car, and others happen when a child ventures into a vehicle and gets trapped. On average, more than three dozen children die of hyperthermia in cars every year, according to statistics kept by San Francisco State University's Jan Null.
