

## IF YOUR VEHICLE GOES INTO WATER, FOLLOW SWOC STEPS IN THIS ORDER IMMEDIATELY:





**60 seconds** is all the time you have to **GET OUT** before water pressure makes it impossible to escape.

## **DO NOT** panic.

**DO NOT** touch your cell phone or call 911. **DO NOT** open the door (water will rush in). **DO NOT** wait for the vehicle to fully sink. **If you wait, your car becomes a coffin.** 

Hundreds of people drown in vehicles every year after crashing into water or getting swept away by flood waters.



## **Safety Tips**





Turn around, don't drown - never drive through water! A few inches of water can sweep a vehicle off the road.



**Practice "submersion drills"** with your family so you are prepared for a real emergency.

- Choose an "escape window," make sure all family members know to go to that window to get out.
- Practice unbuckling and moving to the escape window with your eyes closed and/or in the dark. In a real emergency, it might be dark.



Keep a window breaker/seat belt cutter tool within reach just in case you need it to escape.

Beware! Laminated glass cannot be broken by a window break tool.



Review the "SWOC" escape steps regularly with your family (Seat belts off, Window down, Out the window Children first... do not touch your phone!)
